# Federal Advisory Committees

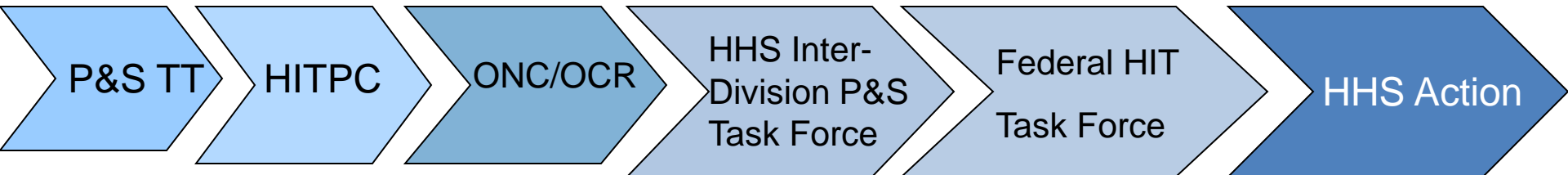


- HIT Policy Committee (HITPC)
  - Privacy and Security Tiger Team
  - Other workgroups, at times address privacy and security (e.g., PCAST workgroup)
- HIT Standards Committee
  - Technical standards for implementing policy
- Make *recommendations*
  - HHS can accept, reject, modify



- Assessing Nationwide Privacy and Security Framework for Health Information Exchange in light of evolving technology
- Building on HIPAA Privacy and Security Rules
- Focus is on filling gaps and strengthening protections to provide an updated, more detailed framework

# HHS Divisions Whose Rules Often May Have a Privacy and Security Impact



- Office for Civil Rights
  - HIPAA Privacy and Security Rules
- Office of the National Coordinator for Health Information Technology
  - EHR standards and certification
  - Governance
- Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services
  - Meaningful use incentive payments
  - Affordable Care Act
    - E.g., CMS sharing Medicare claims data with Accountable Care Organizations



# Rulemaking Process



- Notice of Proposed Rulemaking
  - Generally 30 - 60 day comment period
- Final Rule
  - Must address the comments

# Rulemaking Process



- Request for Information
- Advance Notice of Proposed Rulemaking
- Notice of Proposed Rulemaking
- Interim Final Rule

# Rulemaking Process



- Published in Federal Register
  - <http://www.gpoaccess.gov/fr/>
  - Migrating to <http://www.gpo.gov/fdsys/>
- Sign up to receive daily Federal Register table of contents via email
- Read and submit comments on Regulations.gov
  - <http://www.regulations.gov>



- Comment on proposed provisions that you would like to remain in final rule
- Comment on those you would like removed or altered
  - Propose solutions (e.g., suggest edits to regulatory text)
- Cite to supporting information where available
- Recognize limits of agency authority



- Standards and Interoperability Framework
- Data segmentation project
- Will be seeking public input for
  - Developing use cases
  - Identifying organizations to test potential standard solutions
